BOARD MEETING:

Minutes and budget from last month's meeting were shared with the board. Motion by Jen to approve minutes and supported by Raquel. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Treasurer report read. Report stands as read.

CLERK'S REPORT: Absentee applications were mailed if you elected to receive one. Sheridan Township is receiving a new tabulator from Dominion free of cost, potentially yet in 2024. Looking at the cost of \$5,000 every other year for early voting share to participate with the County.

TRUSTEES' REPORT: None.

GUEST REPORTS: Shared by Mick Haley, Republican candidate for Commissioner introduced himself.

Tom Evans, prosecuting attorney nominee, currently chief assistant for Michelle Ambrozaitis. Michelle Ambrozaitis, not seeking re-election. Prosecutor hat - Sharing about a walk fundraiser for crime victims, Working to receive another federal grant, to fight opioid use.

Ambrozaitis addressed the ongoing court case, she voices she needs help to support the case load. She is running for Circuit Court Ambrozaitis for Judge.

J. Kleinhardt - Axe the tax didn't get enough signatures. Renewable energy-Farm Bureau and Commissioners voted to bring local government power back to townships on renewable energy but it didn't receive enough signatures. School millage and 911 is on the ballot. Septic tank cleaning every 5 years for \$500. Security at County hall has been increased.
